An Overview of Employment Conditions for Language Teachers in Japan

Overview

The present economic crisis is causing many people to worry about their jobs. Language teachers are often in insecure positions even in economically good times and therefore may be feeling particularly vulnerable now. This presentation will survey the different kinds of employment that usually apply to language teachers. Some teachers are self-employed, some work for private schools or companies and some work in the public sector. They also teach at all levels of the education system and to students of all ages. The presentation will discuss general trends as well as specific examples of employment conditions. There will be a discussion about the best ways for achieving as much job security as possible in the current climate.
